Our International vision:

At Redeemer House Ministries in Uganda, our purpose it to rescue, rehabilitate and reunify children. We partner with extended families, such as willing grandparents to provide education and care, which reduces the financial burdens and allows the family an opportunity to break the cycle of poverty.



Rescue: Orphans are placed in our care at Redeemer Children's Home to receive a safe and loving family to care for them.



Rehabilitation: Providing medical care, counseling and discipleship to vulnerable children in Uganda through Redeemer House Children's home, Redeemer Church and Redeemer Academy.



Reunification: Families are reconnected and children who were once without a family are placed with kinship or foster families.

REDEEMER GUEST HOUSE

Providing hospitality to our mission teams is another way we are sustaining our international programs. We coordinate outreach events to give our visitors the most incredible missions experience.

REDEEMER CHURCH (RC)

We gather Sunday mornings for prayer and worship, and during the week for small groups. We use our church to welcome children and families to join us for the word, worship and community.

We travel to Uganda multiple times a year to introduce our xHope Champions to the children, families, and staff we support at RHM. Our mission experiences are prayerfully planned and organized in partnership with our Ugandan staff.



Where does your donation go?


